

# **NOTICE TO MEMBERS**

**DATE: June 10, 2020**

Your Board of Directors re-opened the club facilities on Sunday, May 17, 2020 for members and guests to partake in shotgun shooting activity. The club was re-opened with a number of safety measures in place to address COVID-19 pandemic concerns and operate in a manner that is socially responsible during this challenging time. You have already received a list of "COVID-19" operating rules but they are attached to this notification again to refresh everyone's mind.

Your Board of Directors met on Sunday, June 7, 2020 to discuss a number of club issues including compliance by members and guests with the existing COVID-19 club operating rules. It has been determined that existing compliance with respect to the COVID-19 operating rules is LESS THAN SATISFACTORY and improvement is needed. The primary areas of concern are:

## **1. PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

Club operating rules under existing COVID-19 environment state that shooters must maintain a distance of 2 meters (6.6 ft) between each other when either shooting or waiting to shoot any target venue. Physical distancing less than the amount stated is NOT ACCEPTABLE. Your Board of Directors feel that everyone shooting at the club has the ability to reasonably determine how much distance 6.6 feet is so practice appropriate physical distancing when shooting or partaking in any activity at the club;

## **2. USE HAND SANITIZER PRIOR TO UNDERTAKING SHOOTING OR ANY OTHER ACTIVITY AT THE CLUB**

The club has supplied hand sanitizer at the front desk and at the skeet and 5-Stand venues for use by shooters and individuals waiting their turn to shoot. Applying hand sanitizer is very simple and not a big undertaking so use hand sanitizer.

As an added precaution, wear nitrile gloves when handling remote controls or loading trap machines as several pairs of hands may be touching/handling these items in the course of a shooting day. Nitrile gloves are available at the clubhouse front desk, in the skeet shack and in the 5-Stand shack. They can be disposed of in any club refuse container when no longer required.

### **3. SELF POLICING**

“Self-Policing” is essential if reasonable compliance with club COVID-19 operating rules can be achieved. If you see a member who is not complying with the existing rules either through “forgetfulness” or other reason, remind him/her in a professional manner that the rules are in effect for a reason. If you encounter a member or guest who refuses to comply with the rules, contact one of your Board of Directors accordingly and the Board member will address the issue.

Your Board of Directors insists that members shall comply with our existing club COVID-19 operational rules. If poor non compliance with the rules continues to persist, your Board of Directors will convene a board meeting to determine whether to cease operations at the club again until such time as reasonable compliance can be assured.

Your Board requests that all club members comply with the existing COVID-19 rules.
